ASHOK KUMAR HARIT

Sh Ashok Kumar Harit graduated in Civil Engineering in 1977 from Delhi College of Engineering and joined 'Indian Railway Service of Engineers' (IRSE) in October 1978. Before joining Railways, he served Engineers (India) Ltd., for one year as Trainee Engineer.

In a service span of more than 37 years, so far, he had worked as (i) Assistant Engineer, (ii) Divisional Engineer, (iii) Sr. Divisional Engineer, (iv) Dy. Chief Engineer, (v) Executive Director, (vi) Chief Engineer, (vii) Divisional Railway Manager, (viii) Chief Administrative Officer, (ix) Principal Chief Engineer and (x) General Manager.

He has been directly associated with construction and commissioning of more than 1200 km of new railway line/track; It involved about 160 km of new lines, 630 km of gauge conversions and 390 km of doublings etc., apart from many challenging bridge works over important rivers

As Executive Director (Bridges and Structure)/RDSO, Lucknow (worked for six years) he was associated with evolution of new designs and standards of bridges & structures, formulation and updating of codes and manuals, allied research, field trials & laboratory tests etc.

He has visited USA, UK, Canada, Sweden, France, Netherland etc. on study visits, to attend seminars/trainings in various capacities.

Presently, for the last more than one year, he is working as General Manager of Diesel Locomotive Works/ Varanasi where diesel locomotives, normally of 4500 HP, are being manufactured. It is because of his managerial skills that production of one loco per day has already been achieved for the first time in the history of DLW and during current financial year ever highest production is likely to be achieved.
