Prof. R.P. KAPOOR born in Lahore in 1941. After partition of the undivided India in 1947, migrated to Delhi and did his secondary education from Delhi University ; B.Sc from Agra University ; B.Sc (Mechanical Engineering) from Jiwaji University , Gwalior ; M.E (Applied Thermal Science) in Rorkee Univ. in 1968 and extensive work carried out in the field of mixture of various Refrigerants in IIT Delhi from 1984-1987.

Has a wide experience of more than 36 years of teaching before joining Delhi College of Engineering (1970 -2001). Has also taught at Roorkee University and Regional Engineering College , Kurukshetra .Had joined the college as a senior lecturer and retired as a professor. Taught and guided Undergraduate/Post Graduate students in various subjects related to Thermal Engineering such as Applied Thermodynamics, Heat and Transfer ,Internal Combustion Engines, Turbomachines, Gas Dynamics ,Gas Turbines, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning, Thermal System Design and Analysis, Power Plant / Non Conventional Engineering ,etc. Guided more than 60 projects of both graduate and undergraduate students .Attended summer / winter advanced courses in various field of thermal engineering and also National level conferences .Some of the projects guided were designed / fabricated in the DCE and have become an integral equipment of the Thermal Labs. Had discharged various responsibilities assigned by Delhi administration, Principle, H.O.D and Delhi University from time to time. Worked as an expert in the Selection Board of the government /semi government organisations. After retirement in January 2001, worked as a visiting professor to some of the reputed institutions.
